DICKSON MARINE FABRIC 8 YEAR LIMITED WARRANTY

The 8-year limited warranty protects the original purchaser should Coastguard marine fabric become unserviceable due to color or strength loss from normal usage and exposure conditions, including sunlight, mildew and atmospheric chemicals.

The limited warranty coverage period is eight years from the date of original installation.

This limited warranty covers Coastguard marine fabric only. This limited warranty is valid with proof of purchase from the original purchaser. This limited warranty does not cover normal fabric care and cleaning; damage from misuse, abuse, or improper installation; or costs associated with replacement of the fabric, including labor and installation. Glen Raven's liability is expressly limited to this warranty. Glen Raven reserves the right to inspect the fabric submitted for claim.

Glen Raven will supply new equivalent fabric to replace the fabric that becomes unserviceable during the warranty period. Replacement fabric is warranted under the remaining term of the original warranty.

CLEANING INSTRUCTIONS

GENERAL OR LIGHT CLEANING To clean Coastguard while still on a boat, follow these simple steps:

- Brush off loose dirt.
- Hose down.
- Prepare a cleaning solution of water and mild detergent such as Woolite or Dawn.
- Use a soft bristle brush to clean.
- Allow cleaning solution to soak into the fabric.
- Rinse thoroughly until all detergent residue is removed.
- Air dry.
- May not require re-treatment

HEAVY CLEANING FOR STUBBORN STAINS AND MILDEW Coastguard fabric does not promote mildew growth, however, mildew may grow on dirt and other foreign substances that are not removed from the fabric. To clean mildew, or other stubborn stains:

- Prepare a solution of 1 cup bleach and 1/4 cup of mild detergent per gallon of clean water.
- Soak affected area in solution for 15 minutes.
- Remove stain with a sponge or clean towel.
- Rinse thoroughly to remove all detergent residue.
- Air dry.

Remember to protect the area around your Sunbrella fabric if using a bleach solution. Carpet or other fabrics that are not Coastguard may have an adverse reaction to the bleach. If a boat cover is suitable in size for a washing machine, these steps should be followed:

- Use mild detergent.
- For heavier stains add 1 cup of bleach to wash.
- Wash and rinse in cold water.
- Air dry. Never apply heat to Sunbrella.
- Re-treatment for water and stain resistance will be necessary after machine washing.
